**STEP 1 -** Start by putting your shirt on, followed by the neck wear.

**STEP 2 -** Next, put on your hose (socks), tartan flashes and shoes. Pull the socks up your leg as far as possible, then add the tartan flashes as shown in the image. Fold the top of the socks down and ensure the black elastic holding the flashes in place is hidden.

**STEP 3** - If your Cilt pin is already attached to the Cilt, please leave it in that position. Otherwise, it sits on the front, just above the embroidery on the bottom right. **Please do not feed the pin through both layers of the Cilt, only the front apron**. If your Cilt has no embroidery, position it

around 4 inches from the bottom and 2 inches in from the fringe.

STEP 4 - The Cilt itself is worn across the belly at navel height. Wrap the Cilt around your tummy with the two ends meeting directly in front of you; the back of the Cilt is now in place. Bring the right side over to your left, place the strap through the hole on the side, then through the buckle and secure firmly. Bring the opposite side over to your right and secure the strap(s) firmly. The Cilt is now in place, please ensure the pleats are behind you.

**STEP 5 -** Put your waistcoat on and fasten the buttons.

**STEP 6 -** The Ysgrepan / Sporran is next and should sit just below your waistcoat. If you do not have assistance, fasten the sporran backwards so the waist strap is in front of you and swivel it around into position as shown.

**STEP 7 -** Put your jacket on. If you have a Charlie Jacket as shown, there are no buttons to fasten (the jacket stays open at all times).

**FINISHED** - Double check in the mirror that you look like Tom in the image provided. No shirt should be seen between the bottom of the waistcoat and the top of the Cilt. Ideally, some shirt cuff should be visible. All these minor checks should also be made prior to any photos for the best results.

**PLEASE NOTE** - The Fly Plaid is always worn over the left shoulder. The brooch is pinned through the Fly Plaid but **NOT** the Jacket. The Fly Plaid is usually worn by the groom only.
